LIST OF SERVICES

HANDS

A voluntary in-home visitation for new and expectant parents that helps foster healthy pregnancy and births, stable child growth and development, safe homes, and self-sufficient families.

GREATER LOUISVILLE HEAD START

Early Head Start is designed for income-eligible children from birth through age 3, with families choosing between daily programs at learning centers around Louisville or weekly home visits.

SCHOOL-BASED SERVICES

Family-centered help designed to improve academic success and strengthen families while building character, social competency, and bolstering relationships between the student, family, and school.

CHILD ADVOCACY CENTERS

The CAC establishes a safe, child-friendly environment providing best practices for children and non-offending family members impacted by child sexual abuse, as well as forensic interviews in cases involving child physical abuse and related crimes.

COUNSELING SERVICES

Clients seek treatment to recover from child physical and sexual abuse, community and family violence, crime, and other types of trauma. Additionally, counselors help clients navigate parenthood, child behavioral problems, school issues, family transitions, such as divorce, blended families and health issues.
